St. Scholastica has risen to the challenges imposed by the COVID pandemic by making live masses available online, conducting meetings via Zoom, expanding our use of Flocknote (including mass and adoration reservations), and more. Over the last 6 months, several technology needs and opportunities for service have become apparent. St. Scholastica is forming **God's Tech Revolution Apostolate!** Middle school students and adults are encouraged to apply. Members will provide technical support to parishioners and parish staff while trouble-shooting problems; building the parish website; broadcasting the mass and parish events; and designing, creating and publishing stories, reports, videos and photographs.
