LIVING THE FAITH

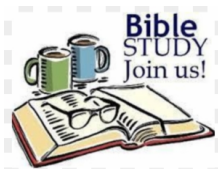

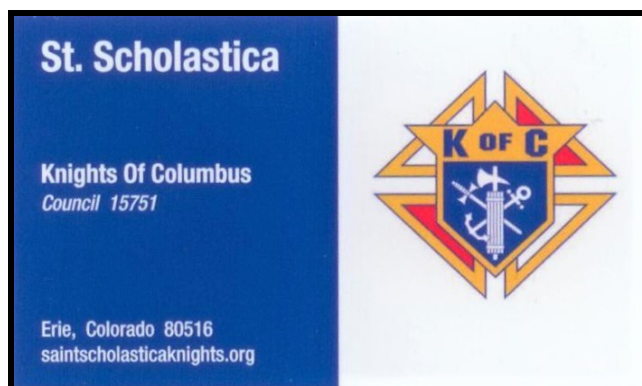
