that happened to him while he was stationed on a ship in the Navy.

After a night of hard work in which he and his men were tired and in need of rest, a Protestant chaplain approached him while he was waiting to have breakfast. The chaplain said that he had been deep in prayer the night before and that he had a deep impression that God was calling Wedow to the Catholic priesthood.

"My first reaction was anger, I wondered who he had been talking to," Deacon Wedow said. "I had been thinking of becoming a priest, but I had little faith in my vocation to step out for the Lord," he told the assembly.
