Saint Project

Project Overview:

In class, students will prepare a project about their saint. Their project will be filmed and posted to the Parish's YouTube channel, and optionally, they can come on camera and tell about their Saint. If they'd like they can dress as the saint, and/or bring props such as a poster, book, musical instruments, and items that represent their saint.

- 2. Creating a game, song, image, etc. that illustrates the story
- 3. Create a diorama
- 4. Create a poster
- 5. Write a comic strip

Project Description:

You child should gather the information to present about their saint to the virtual saint fair. Ideas include but are not limited to:

- 1. <u>General Information</u>: Name, Birthday, Feast Day, where they were from, are they a patron saint and if so, who do they represent.
- 2. <u>Some background information</u>: such as what are some of the things they are known for or important events in their lives.
- 3. A Picture: A Picture of the Saint.
- 4. Quotation:
- 5. Interesting Facts: some interesting facts about the saint
- 6. Prayer: a specific prayer either for the Saint's intercession or written by the saint.

7. How does this Saint inspire you: An explanation of why you chose this saint and how this saint may pertain to your life, things about the saint that you found to be inspirational to you?

For the video, students can use props such as a poster, book, musical instruments, and items that represent their saint. If you are completing this at home, and you would like your child to be included in the Virtual Saint Fair, please send a video of your child presenting their Saint's information to the teacher so that it can be added to the fair.
